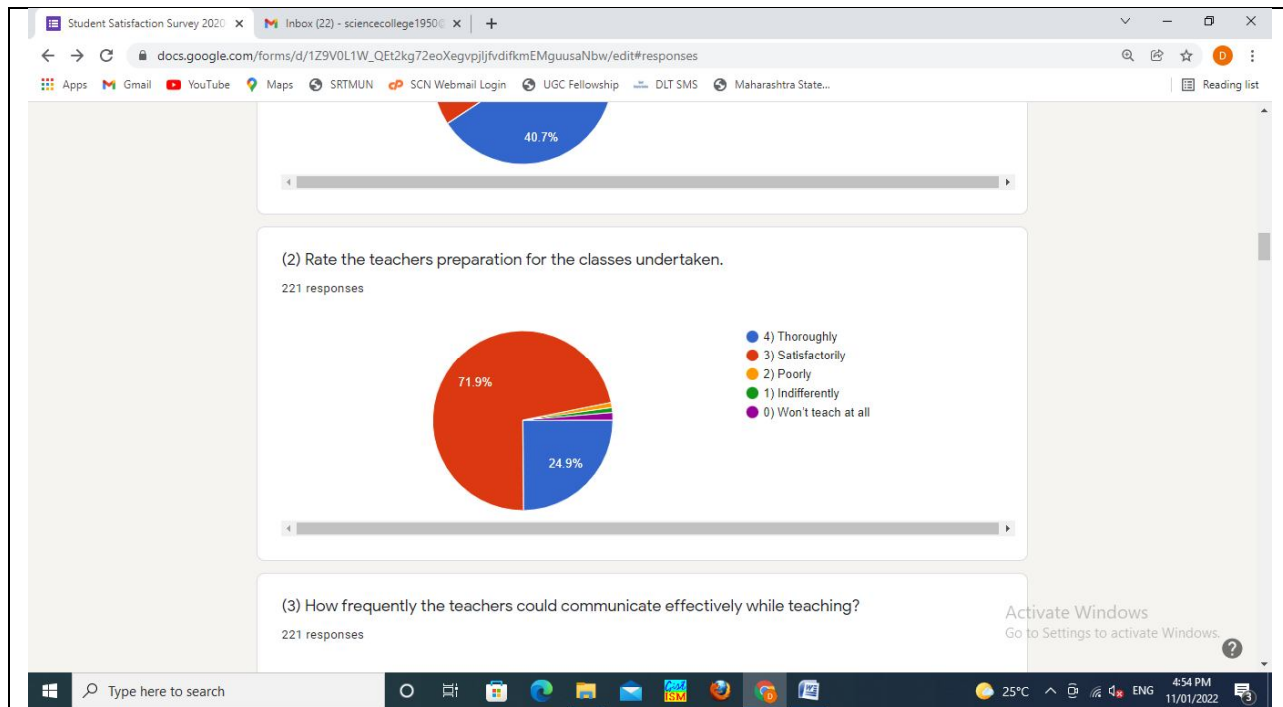




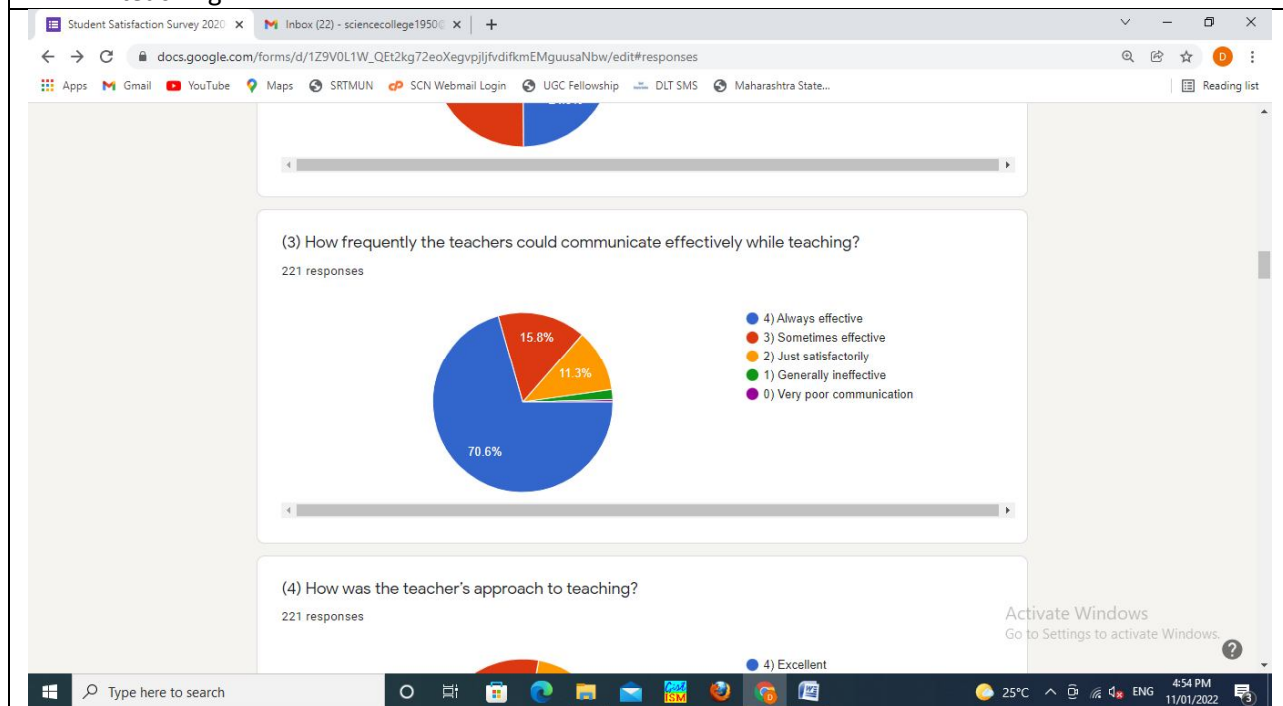
The total responses include students of Mathematics, Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Applied Mathematics, Computer Science, Zoology departments.



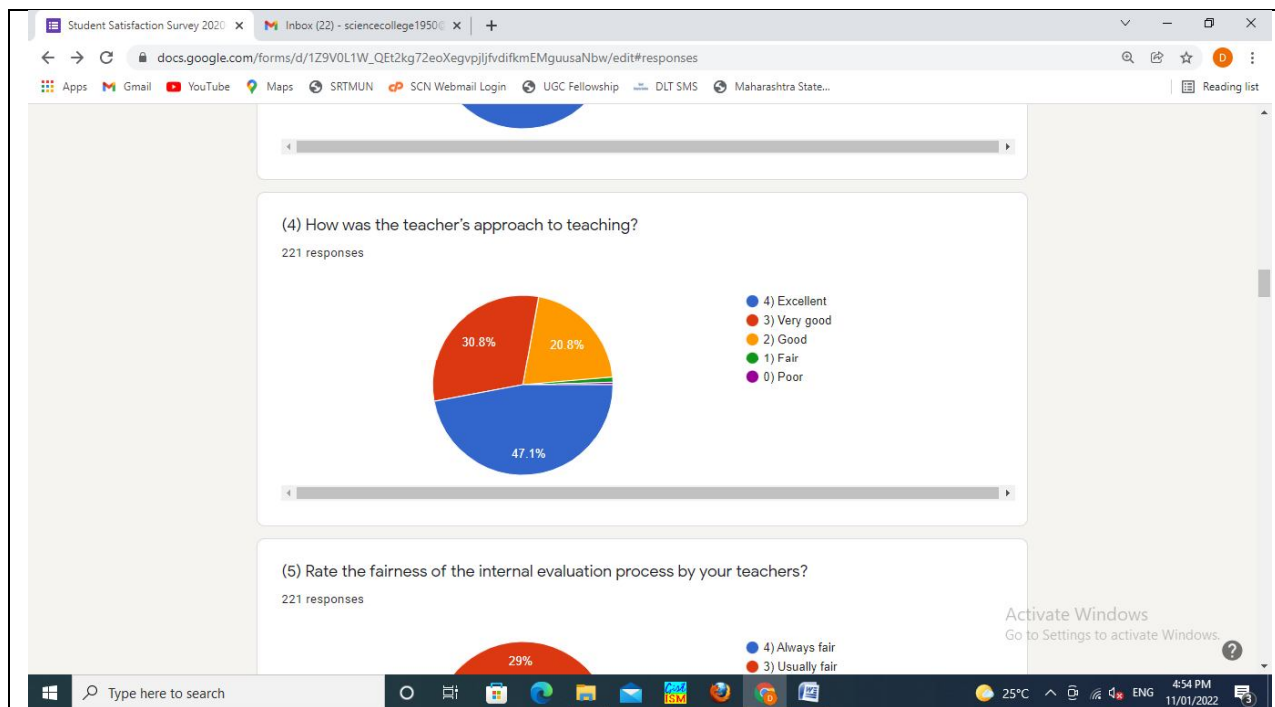
1) This year teachers conducted on-line classes and near about 75 percent students agree that more than 70 percent syllabus is covered.



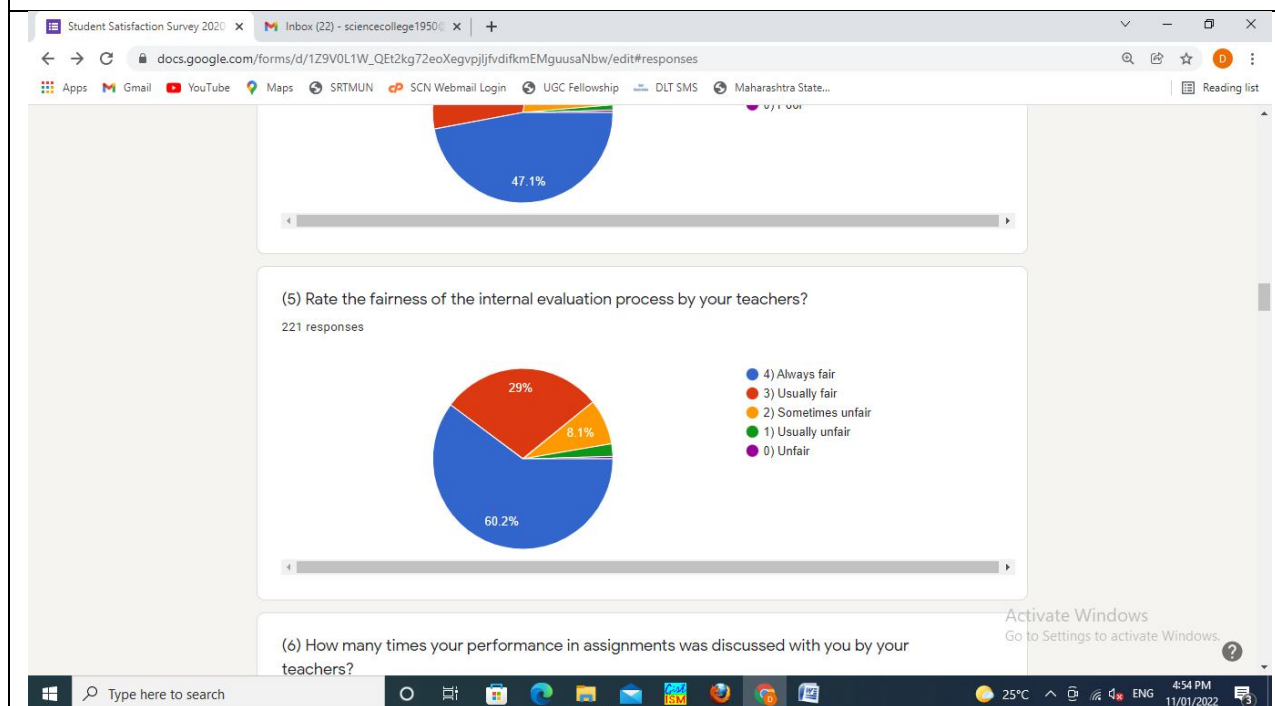
2) 96.8 percent students are satisfied by the teacher's through preparation and their effective teaching.



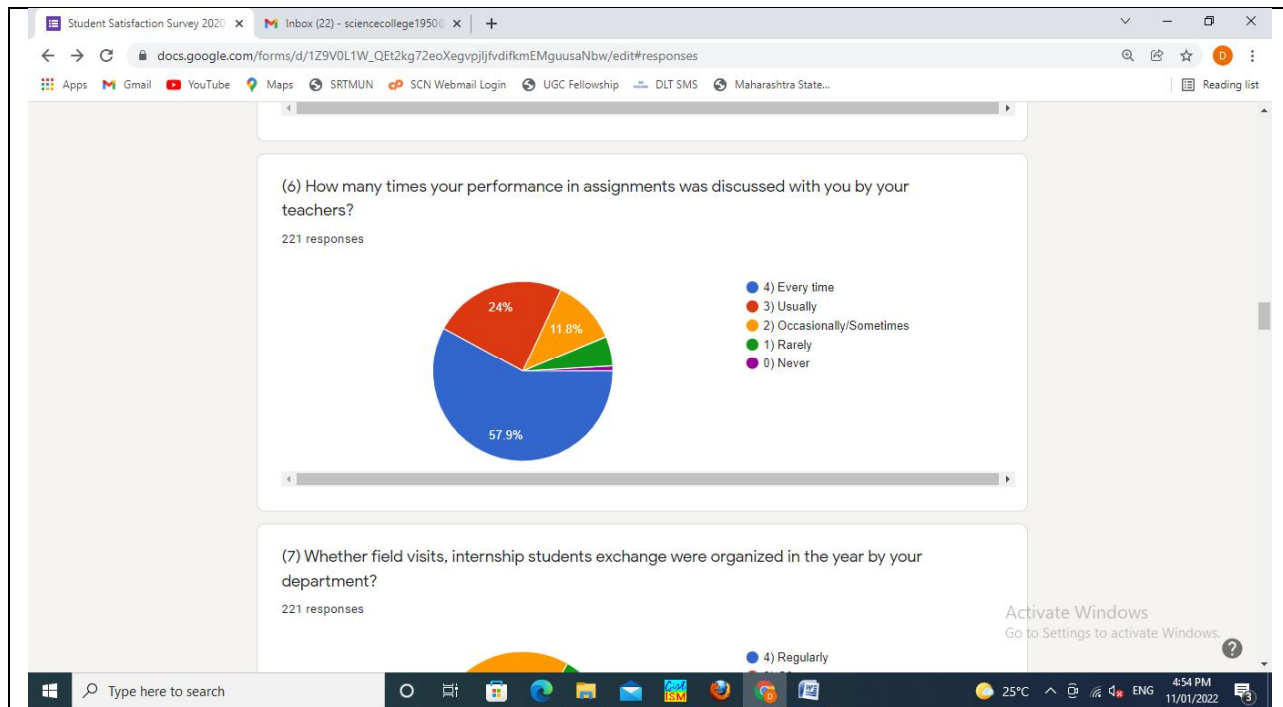
3) 97.7 % students responded that the teachers could communicate effectively while teaching and they could convey their content successfully.



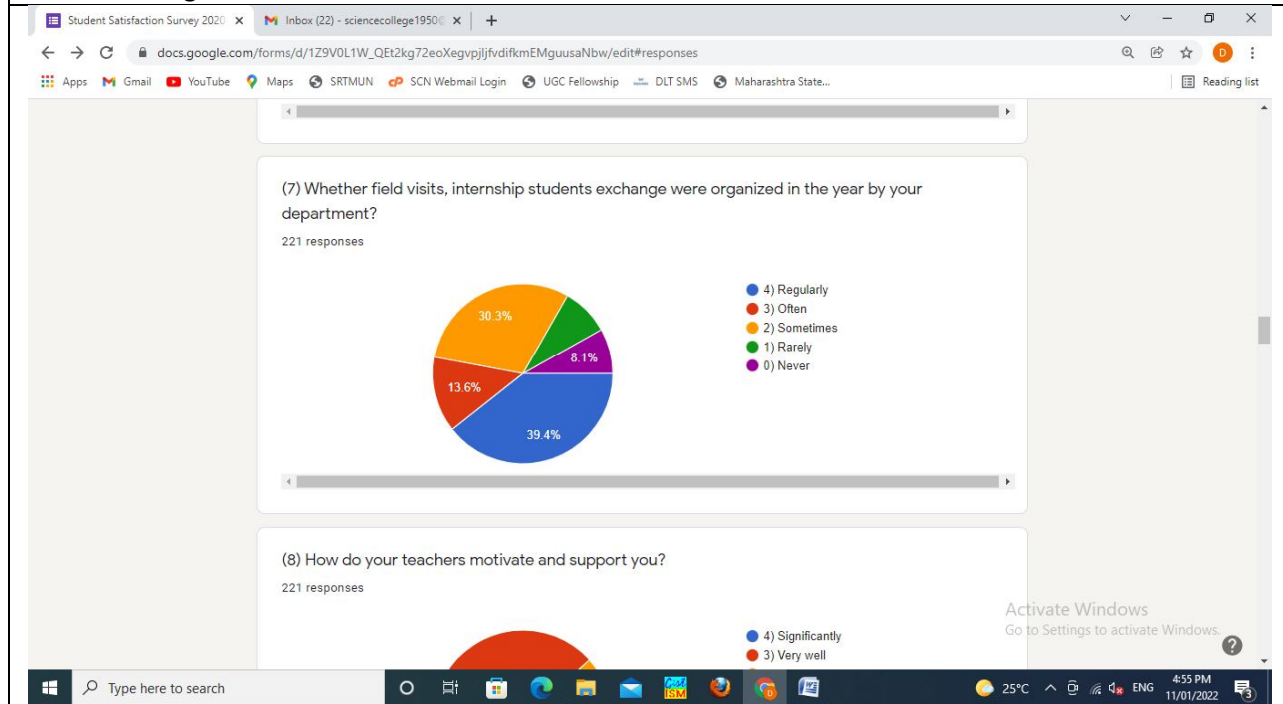
4) Teachers' approach to the teaching is excellent, good and very good according to 97.7 % students.



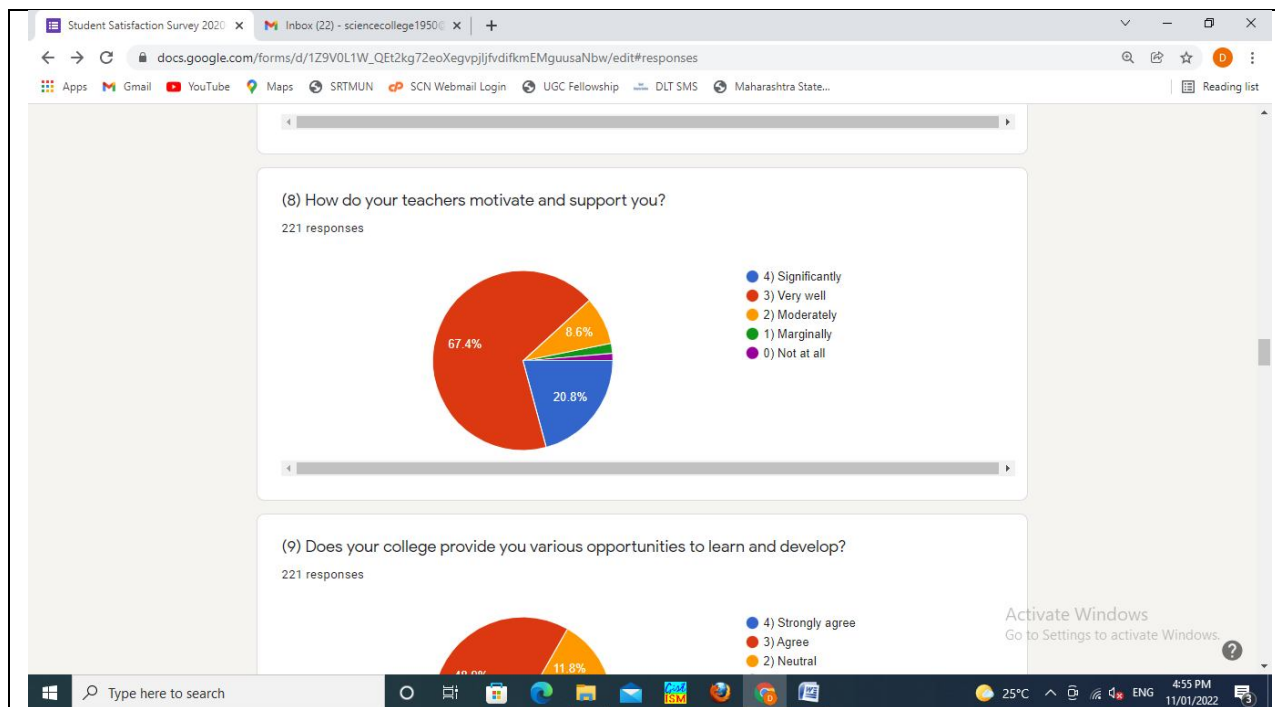
5) This year online internal examinations are conducted and the evaluation process is flawless and fair according to 97.3 % students.



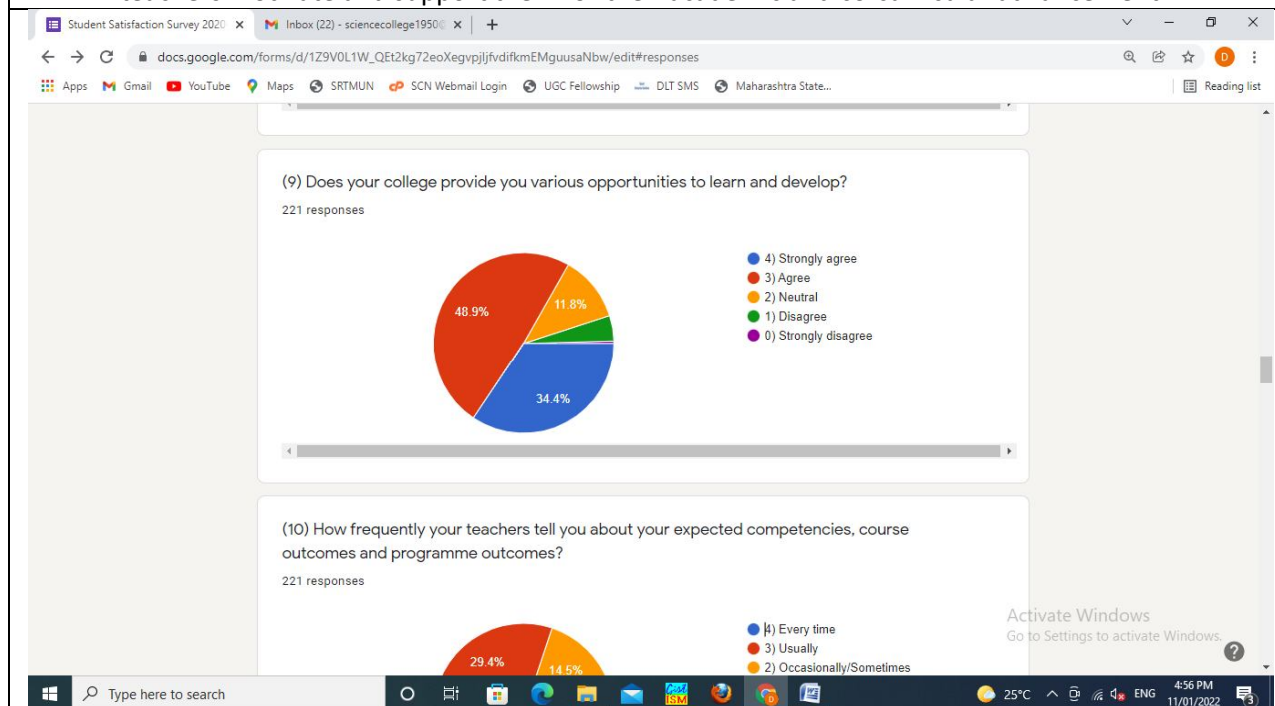
6) Teachers are giving assignments for the effective teaching and learning process and they discuss the performance of the students to improve their performance and to correct their mistakes during the examinations.



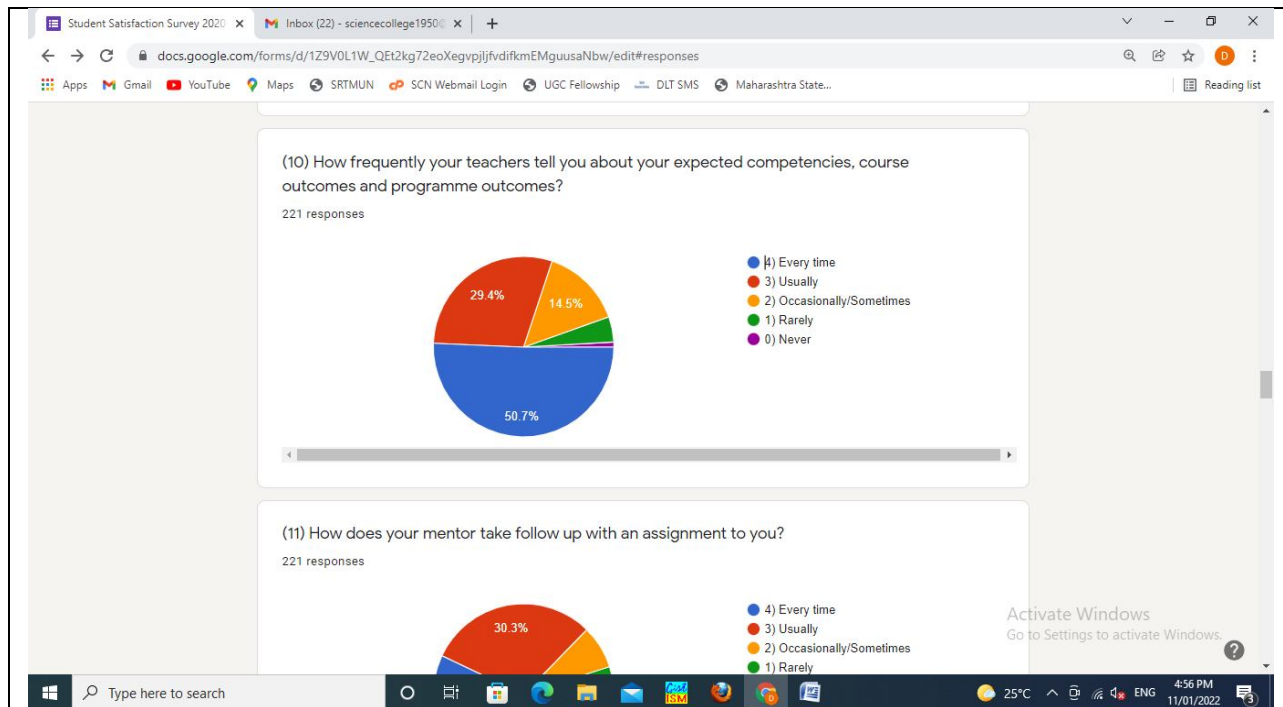
7) The above graph shows that according to 91.4 percent students, the field visits, internship for the students are regularly organized in this year for the strengthening of the students' learning experiences.



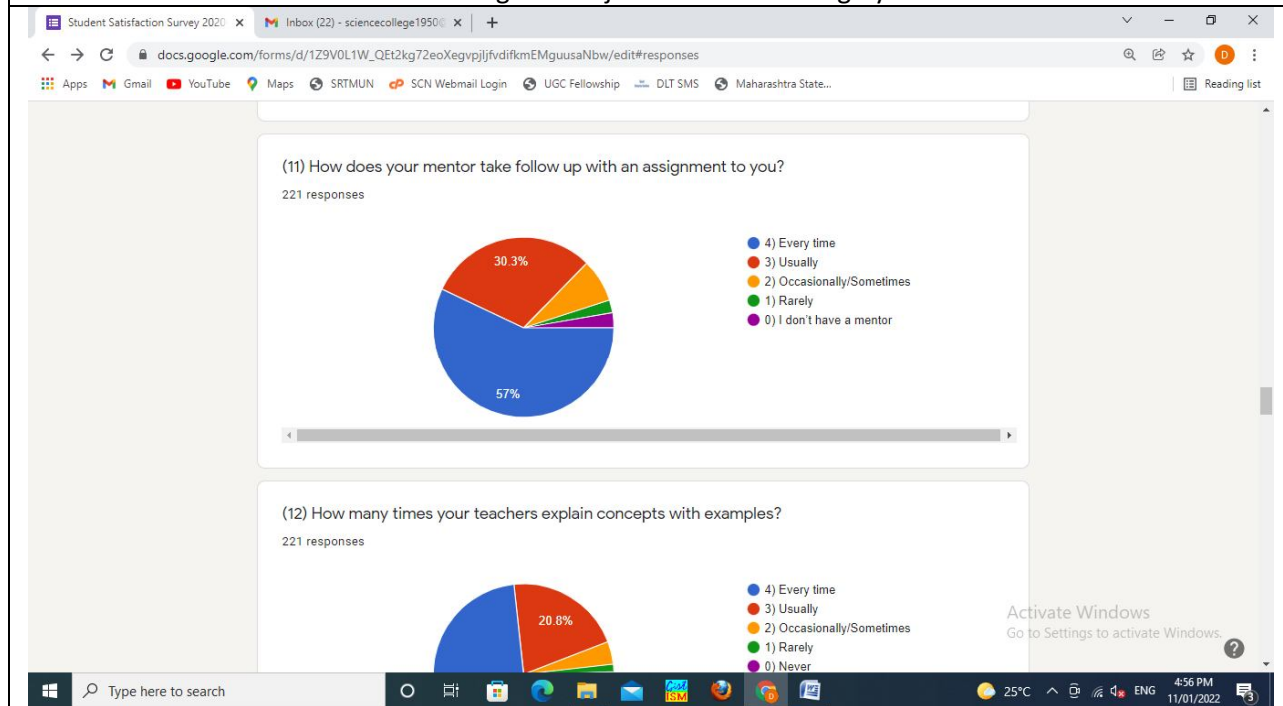
8) According to the graphical representation of the feedback, 96.8 percent students say that their teachers motivate and support them for their academic and co-curricular advancement.



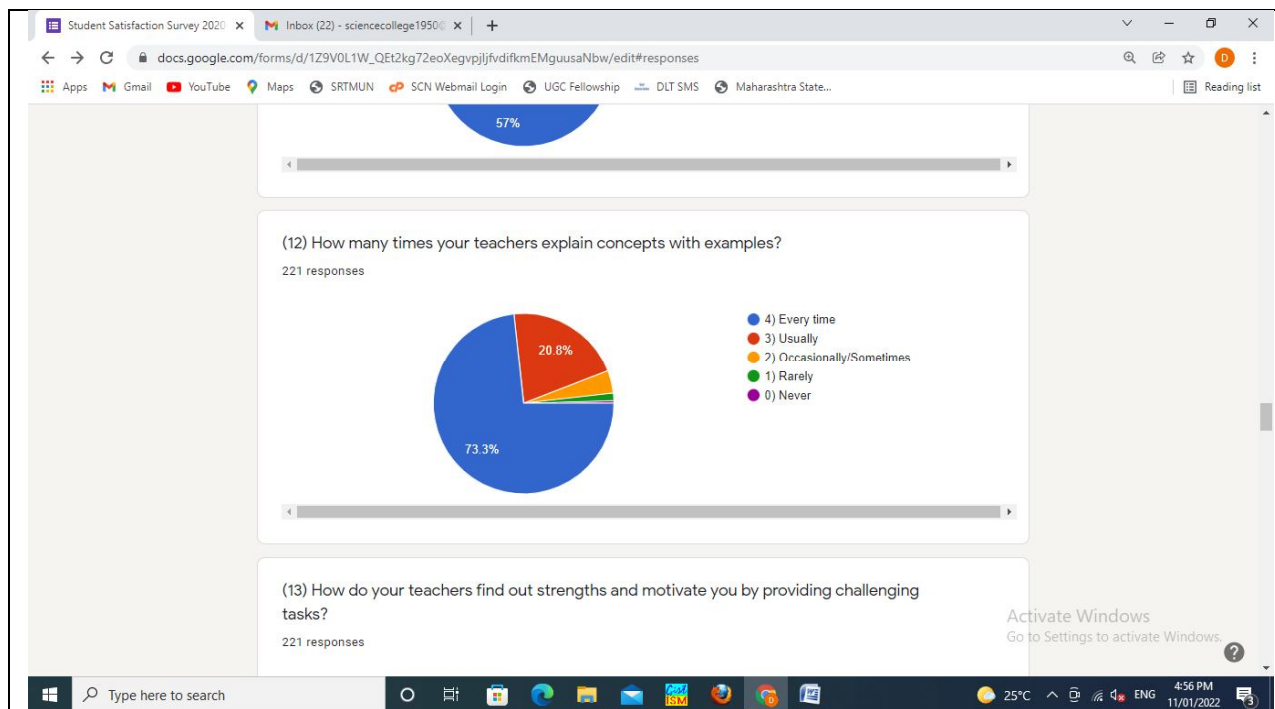

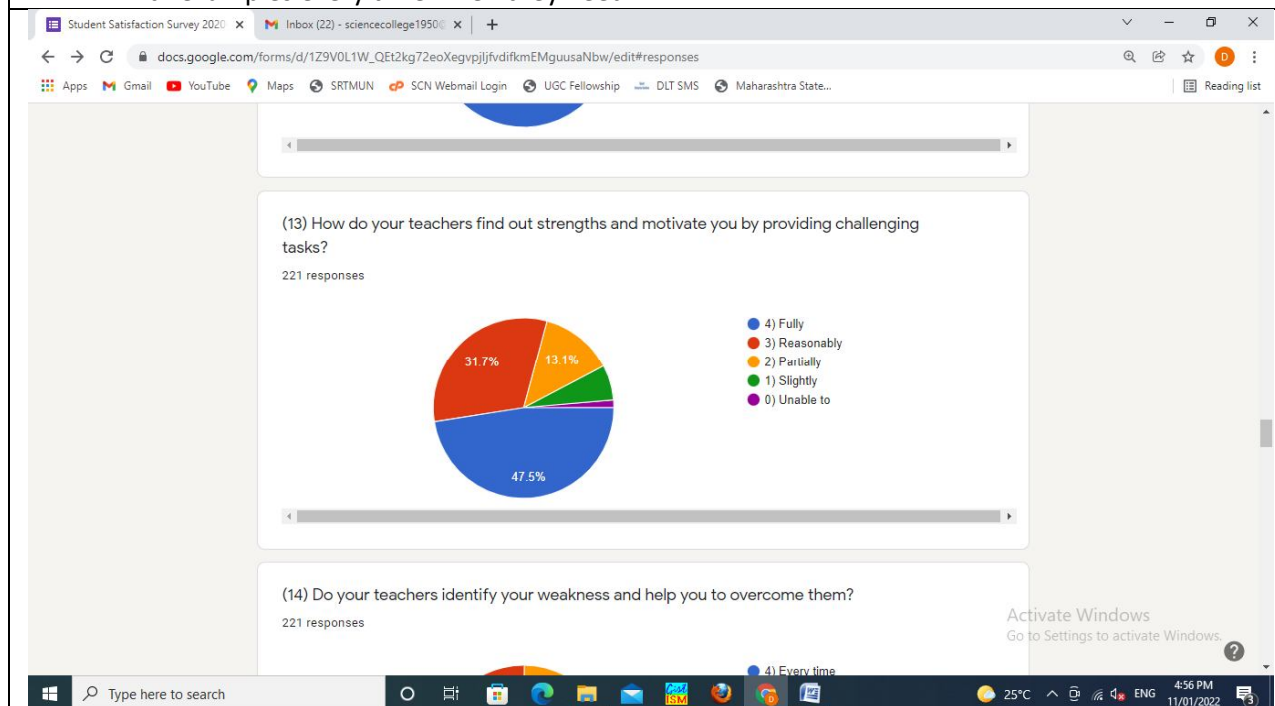

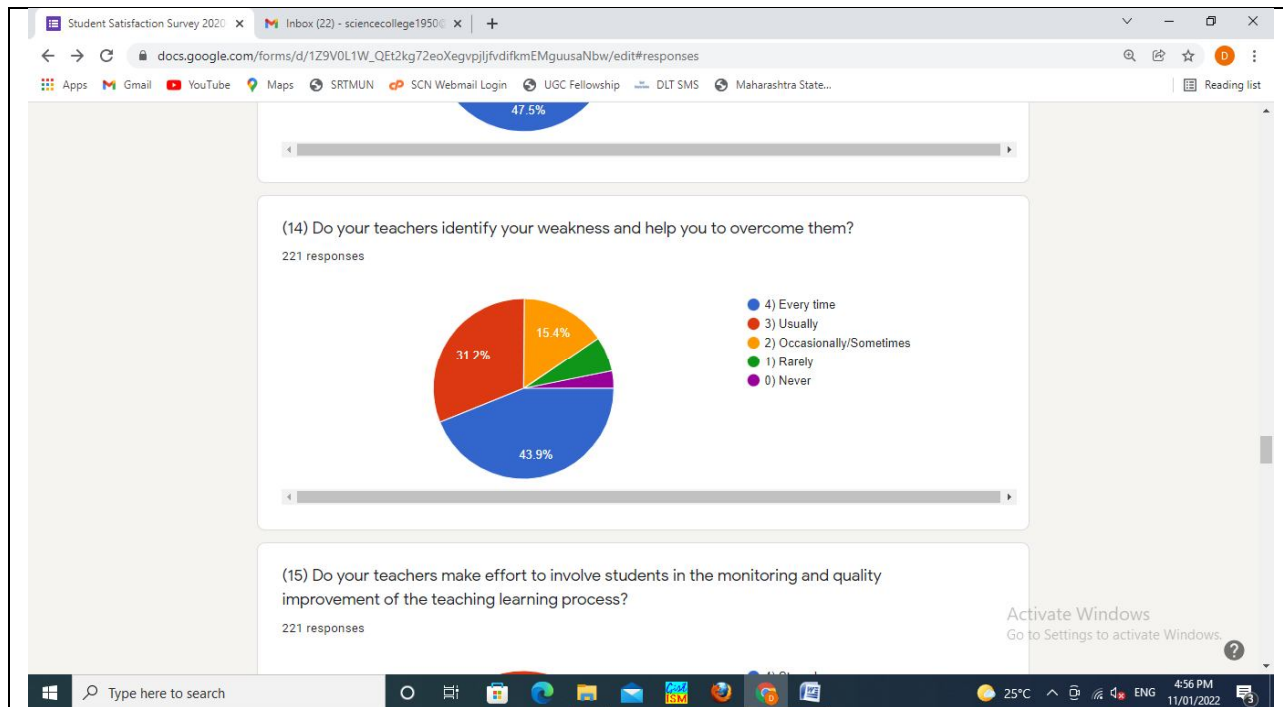
11) The mentor are taking regular follow up according to 57 % students and 30 % students say that their mentors are usually take the follow up of the assigned task to them.



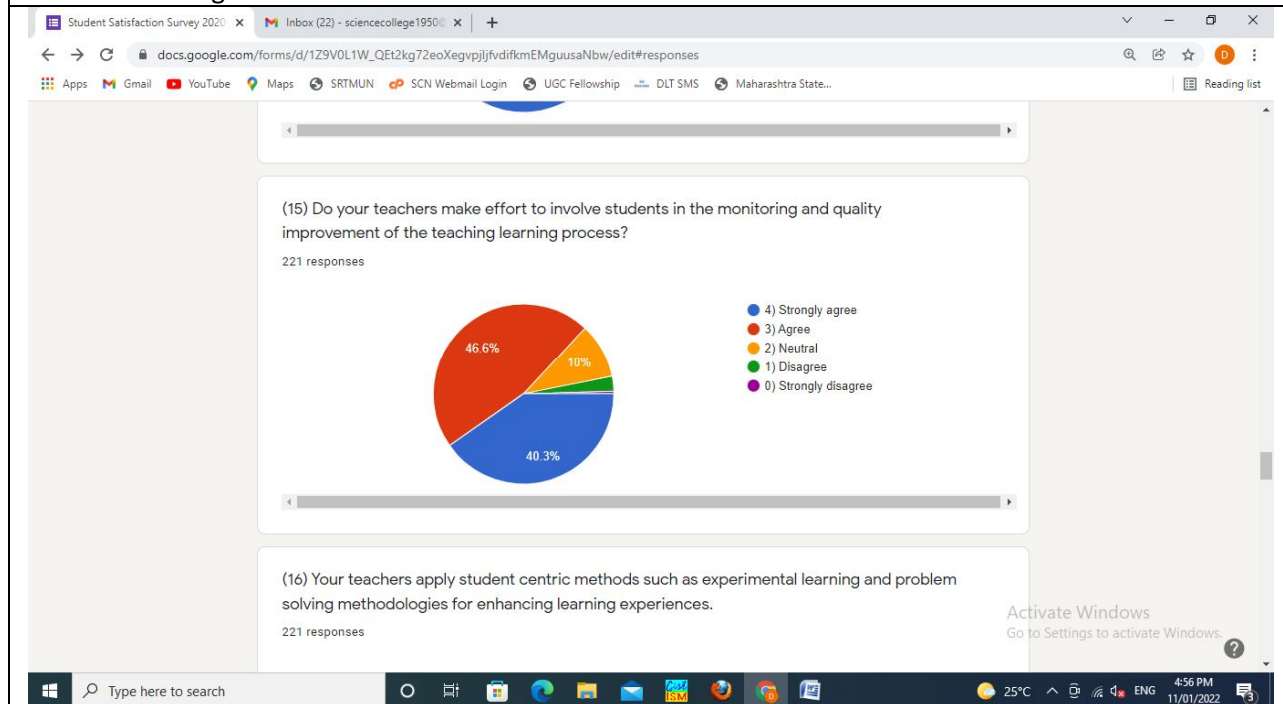
12) Most of the students are satisfied to the helping attitude of the teachers who explain concepts with examples every time when they need.



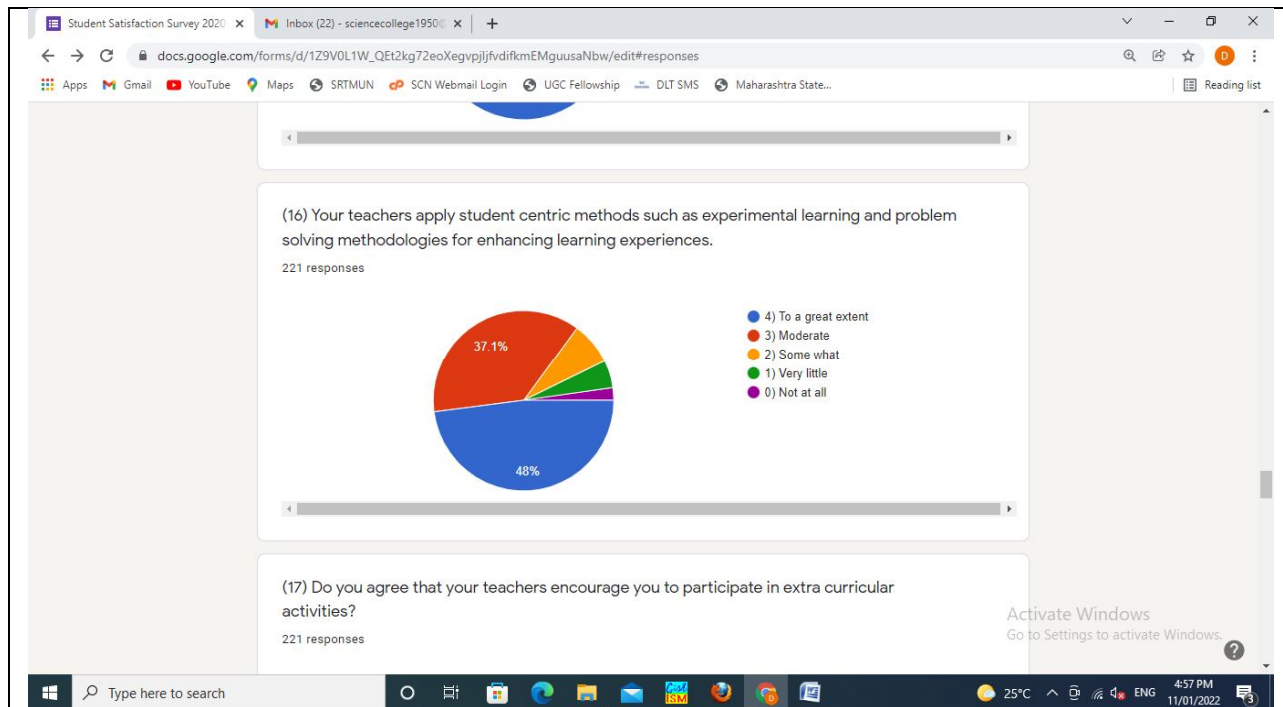
13) According to 79.2 % students, the teachers are identifying the students' strengths and they motivate them by providing them challenging assignments.



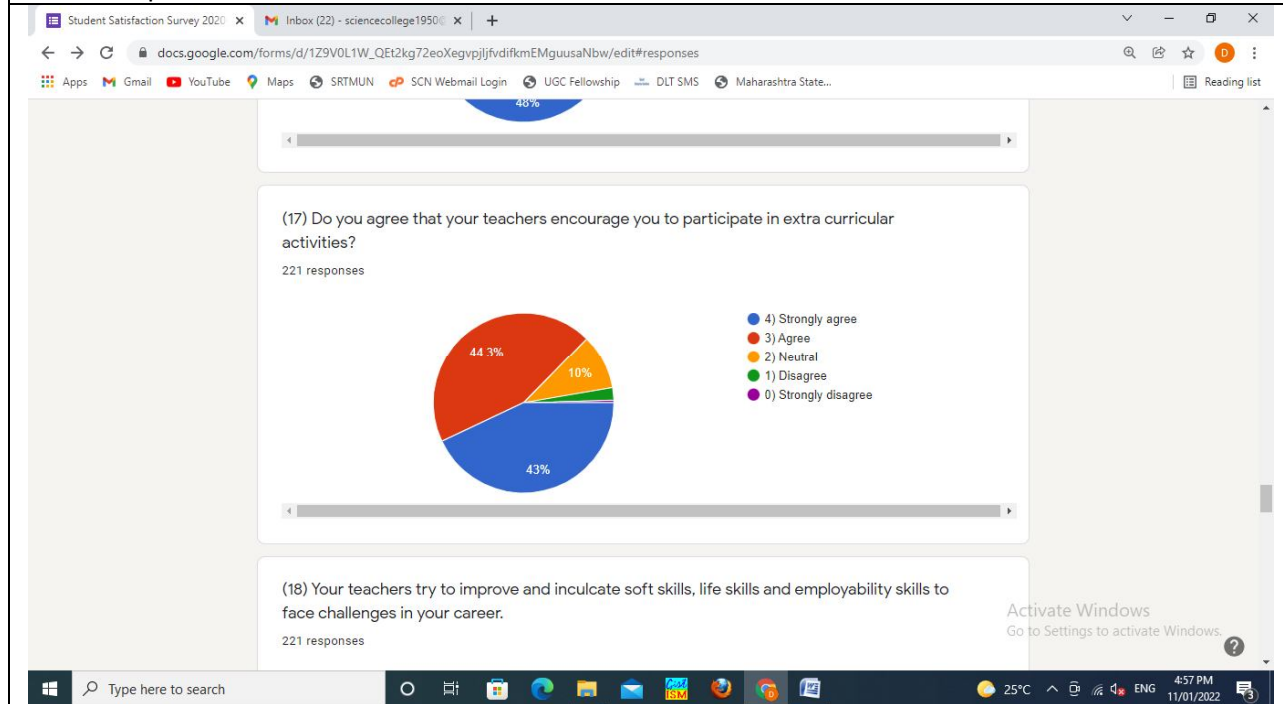
14) According to the above graph 75 % students signify that teachers are identifying the weak students with the help of continuous assessment and providing them with the remedial coaching.



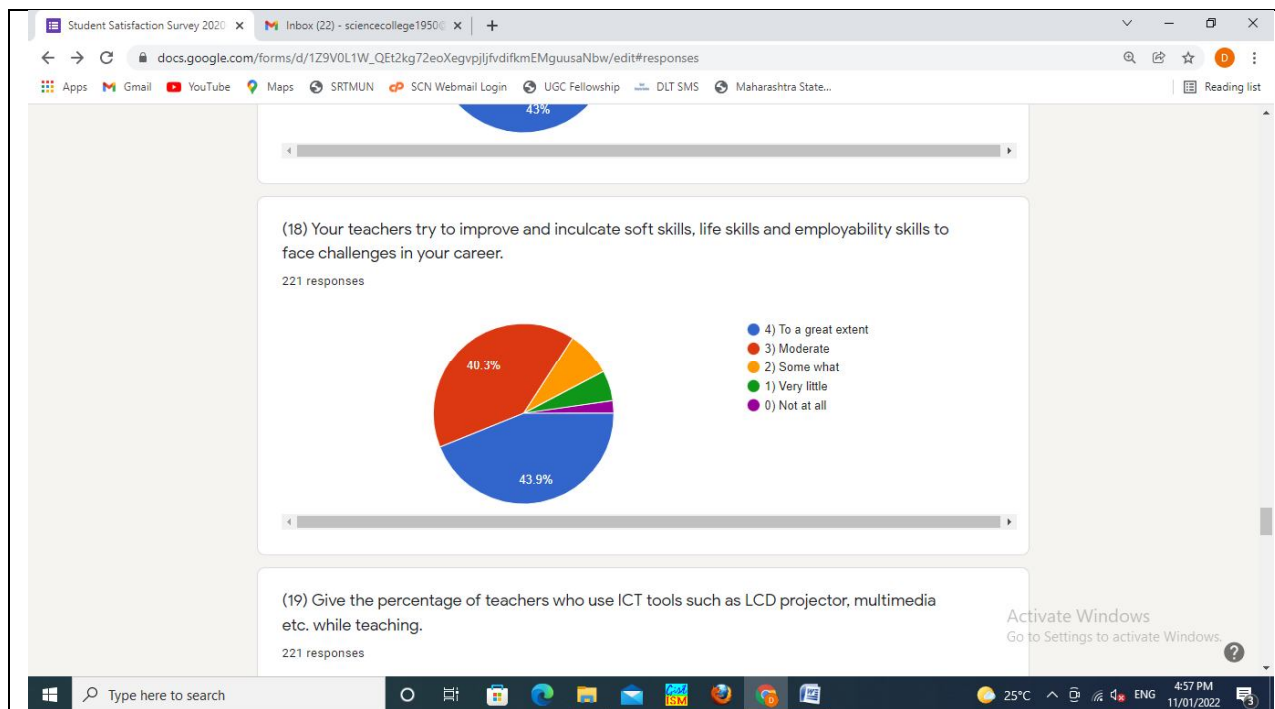
15) The graph shows that 96.9 % students say that their teachers make efforts to involve students in the monitoring and quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



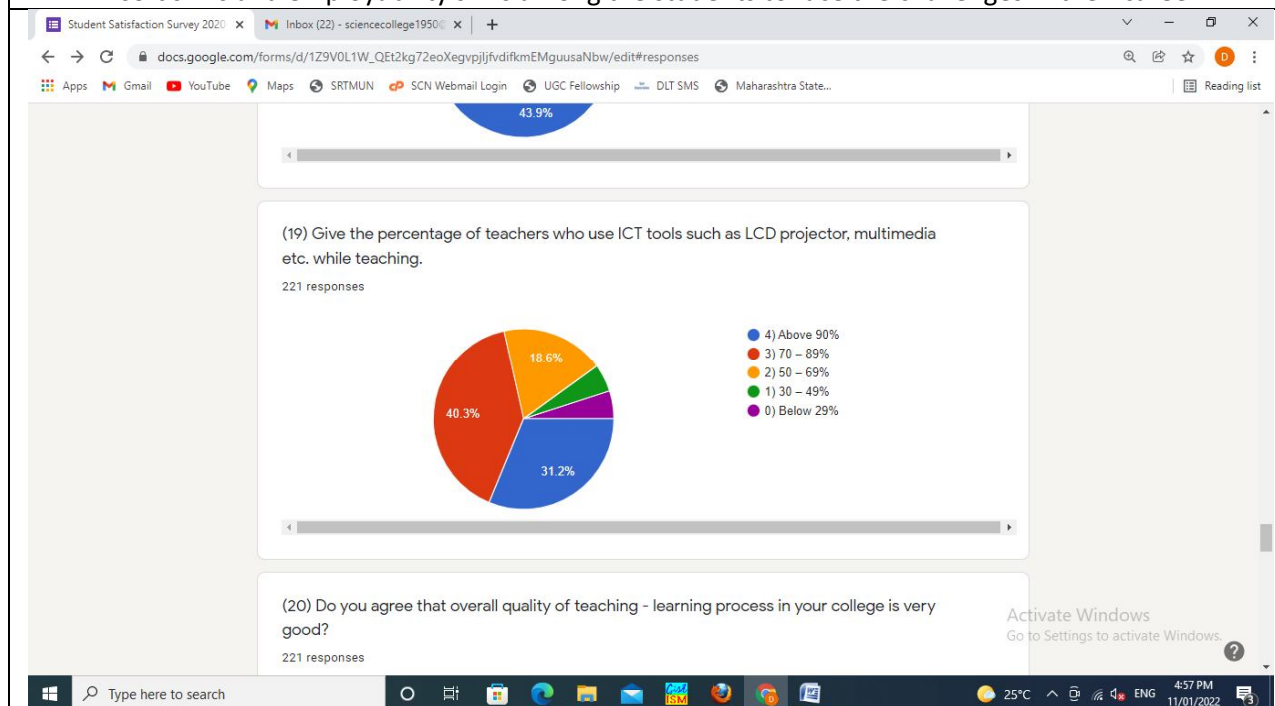
16) 85 percent students say that their teachers are applying students' centric methods such as experiential learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing the learning experiences.



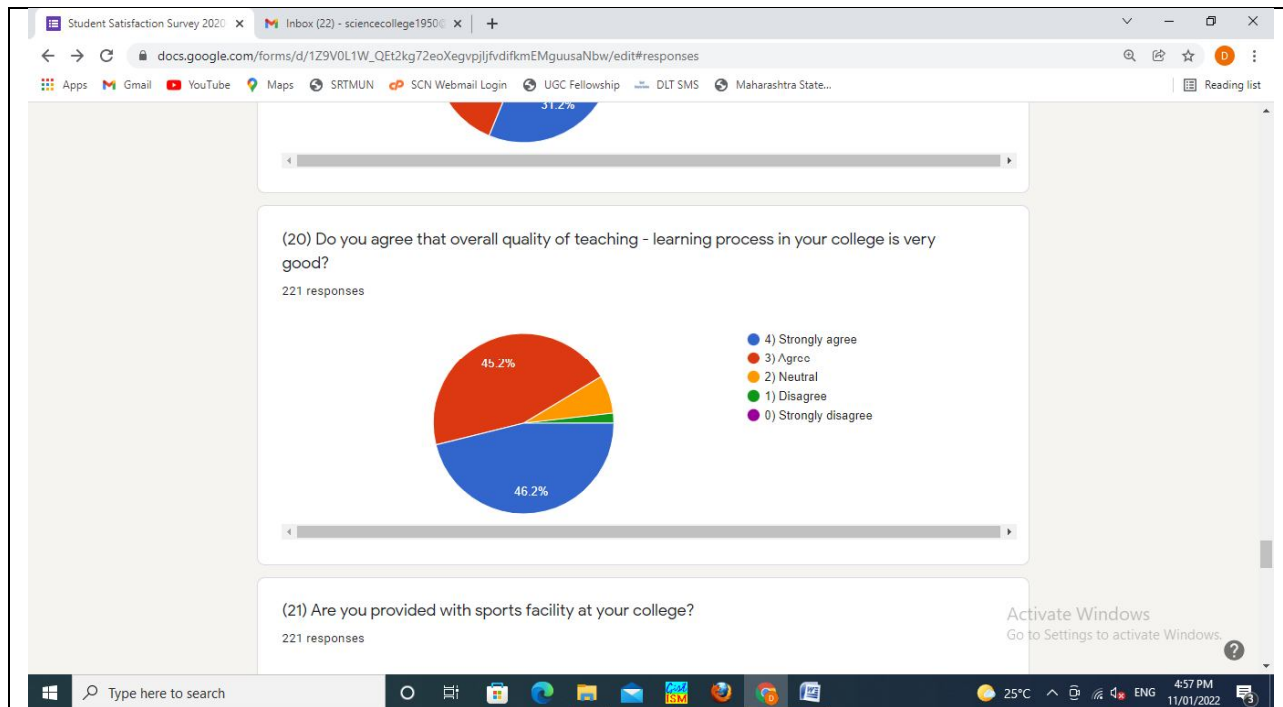
17) The graph shows that 87 % students say that their teachers encourage them to participate in extra-curricular activities.



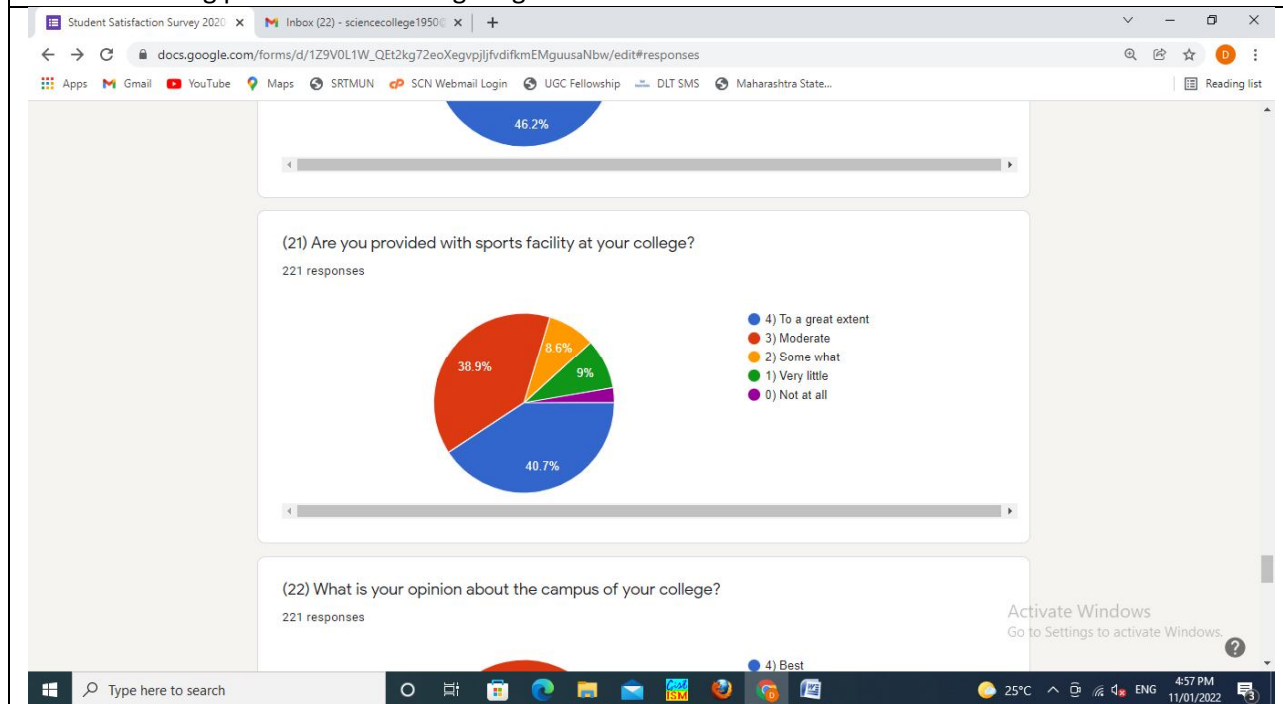
18) According to above graph, 84 % students say that their teachers are improving and inculcating soft skills and employability skills among the students to face the challenges in their career.



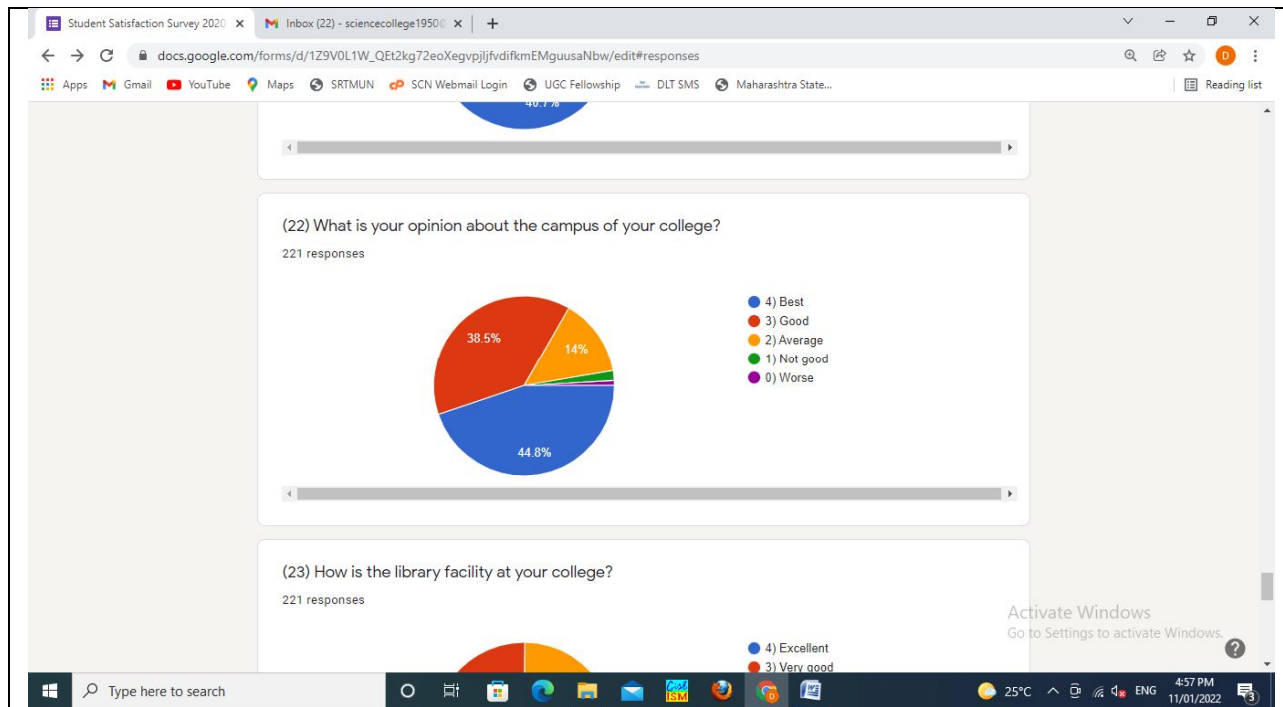
19) The above graph presents the significant and notable use of ICT tools such as LCD Projector, multimedia, etc. for teaching



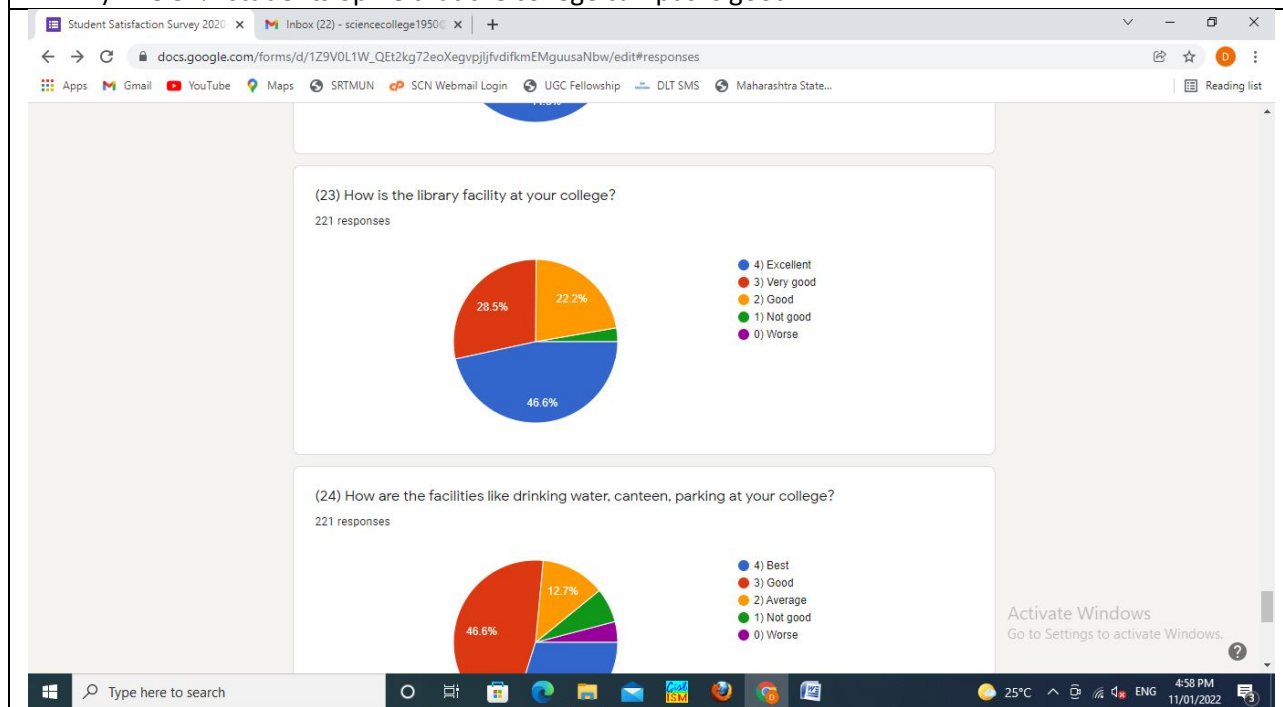
20) The above graph shows that 91 percent students say that the overall quality of teaching – learning process in the college is good.



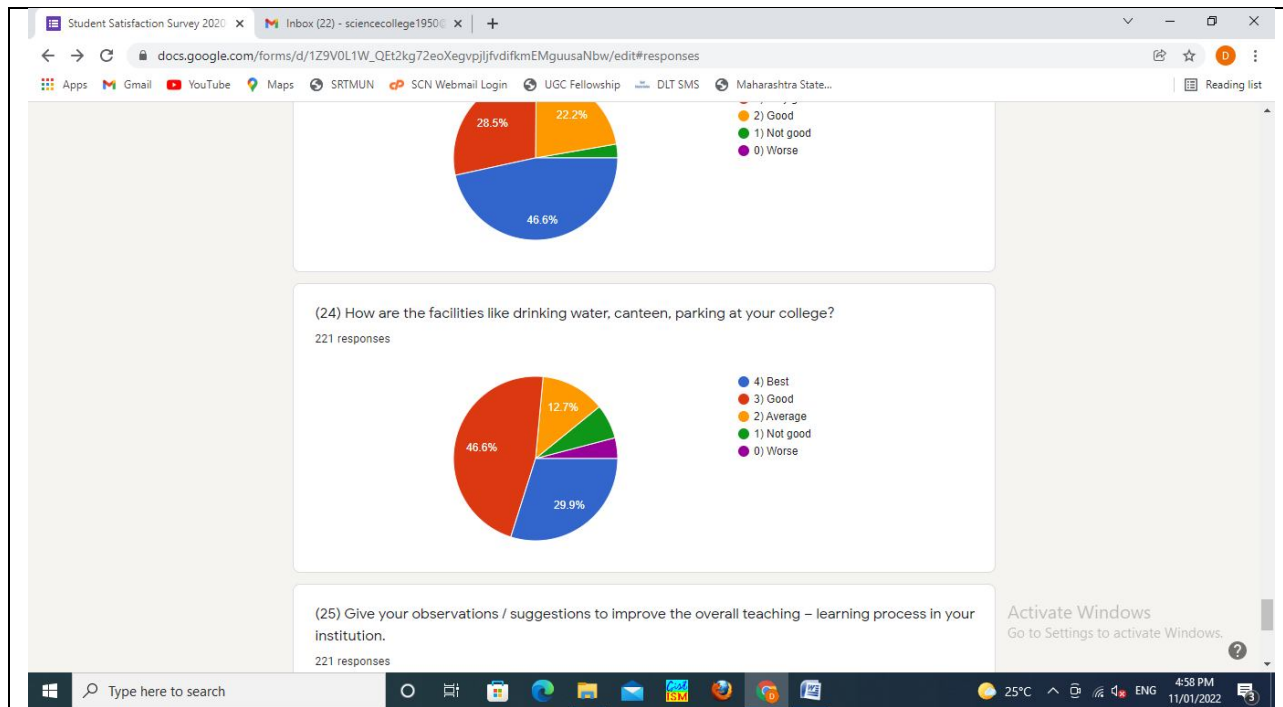
21) The college provides the sport facility according to 78% students.
