

(ii) Action Taken on the suggestions:


All the suggestions are forwarded to the Principal and IQAC coordinator and following actions are taken over the suggestions.

The suggestions given by students are forwarded to the Principal and IQAC coordinator. Following actions are taken on the suggestions given by students.


- 1. Teachers of college provide extra knowledge through remedial coaching


Feedback of Alumni is collected regarding the courses taught during their tenure in the college based on the 4-point scale as shown on the following parameters:
