Introduction: Attainment of various Program Outcomes is measured on the basis of performance of the learners in different curricular and co-curricular activities.

The College uses various methods to measure Program Outcomes and the attainment level of the learners. Some of the Methods are enlisted as below-

- 1. Continuous internal monitoring of students while doing regular practical and handling different instruments to evaluate modern tool usage.
- 2. Continuous internal evaluation is done conducting unit tests, assignments, seminars and other participative learning methods to evaluate the progress of the students.
- 3. Project based work in PG Classes to evaluate the efficiency to conduct investigation and do research related complex problems and design development solutions.
- 4. Observing the participation in sports, cultural activities, Science Day Exhibition, Eco- friendly committee activities, Earns and Learn Activities, Workshops, Conferences, etc. to evaluate the students.
- 5. Teachers also observe students actively participating in tree plantation activities, rain water harvesting, NSS, NCC, etc. to check students showing social responsibility and devotion towards environment.
- 6. Continuous assessment also considers participation of learners in different competitions and curricular activities like poster presentation, elocution competition, paper presentation, seminar, power point presentation, etc.
- 7. Teacher records students' ability to use ICT techniques to acquire modern tool usage and employability skills.
- 8. Learners' involvement in seminars, group discussions, field visits and study tours, industrial visits is used for the assessment.
- 9. In addition to this, learners are also evaluated constantly on the basis of their punctuality, regularity, and their shared responsibilities, participation in classroom activities and co-curricular activities and overall quality of their behavior.
- 10. Use of question-answer methodology to check communication skills and soft skills for creative and critical thinking of learners.










10. Do you know the jobs you might be able to get after completing the UG/PG program?








16. Did you participate in community based projects or service learning activities (NSS, NCC)?




17. Did your UG/PG program include internship programs and exposure to industry as a part of syllabus?


