Grievance and Redressal Cell Report 2022-23

College has Grievance and Redressal Cell to solve the complaints lodged by the students for their academic and infrastructure difficulties. Grievance and Redressal Committee members take into account the complaints lodged by the students and arrange the meeting with the students along with the head of the institute. i.e. the Principal of college.

The student drops their complaints in the complaint box or share online through email. The committee also solves the personal problem besides academic and campus matter. The complaints of students are solved in a stipulated time with proper justice.

During the academic year 2022-23 five students lodged the complaints about drinking water, books of library.

Some students asked filtered clean drinking water in classroom. Grievance Committee solved this difficulty by installing two water filter plant in front of the class one for boys and other for girls.

Some students lodged complaint about dustbin in every class. They have suggested to drop the waste in the dustbin which are present in the campus and dustbins are kept in corridor also. Some students want more than two books from library.

College made facility to issue more books in the reading room. Some students require more lab facility in the lab for research and project. Respective department are making appropriate arrangement for practical and projects.
