Resource Mobilization Policy

A) Aims and Objectives:

C) The College has well established mechanism for maintaining existing resources.

- The college has set of procedures for maintenance of infrastructure and equipment. This is primarily attained through the monitoring of various committees like Purchase Committee, Campus Development Committee, Infrastructure and Development Committee, CDC and IQAC with necessary support systems.

Examination Evaluation Mechanism Policy

The college has robust mechanism of Continuous Evaluation in several ways. At the beginning of the year the information related to Examinations is disseminated in the college calendar in college diary and on the college website and easily conveyed to the staff and students. The coordinator of Examination Committee is in-charge of the Internal Tests and the University examination. Students are continually evaluated using the following methods and Mechanism:

Evaluation and Assessment Methods	Evaluation Mechanism
Attendance	The University requires at least a 75 % attendance as eligibility criteria for the students in order to appear for the university examinations. The college motivates students to have more attendance than this criterion.
Internal Tests	Internal Unit Tests are conducted to evaluate students in accordance with the affiliated University's regulations and norms. The coordinator with the Principal defines the plan of the Internal Assessment Test Schedule for the academic year. The dates of internal tests, evaluations and information to control the malpractice are incorporated in the schedule. The timetable is shared amongst the staff members and students.
University Examination	The College strictly adheres Rules, regulations, and recommendations given time to time by the affiliating university for the smooth conduction of University examinations. For the benefit of enrolled students, university circulars are displayed on the notice board. In the orientation session, students know about the exam schedule, restrictions, and evaluation process.

Assignments Submission	Every year all subject teachers plan and announce the topics and final dates for students to complete the assignments at the end of each chapter, which are graded and counted for Continuous Internal Assessment. The basis for evaluation is the quality and timeliness of the assignments' submission by students.
Class Room Discipline Observation and Performance	Classroom discipline is maintained by class representatives. Teachers also keep watch on students and assess their classroom performance.
Participation in Co-Curricular Activities	The College inspires and assesses students to participate in all co-curricular activities within and outside the College. Students' performance is observed during co-curricular activities. It helps teachers for evaluation.
Subject Based Viva-Voce& Seminars	Subject-based viva-voce and seminar are used to evaluate students. The performance in the viva-voce and seminars is helpful to assess the students.
Report Writing Skills	Field work is also assigned to the students. Field work reports are submitted to the supervisors for the assessment. The quality of the reports has a noteworthy impact on each student's internal marks.
Evaluation through Effective Presentation	Seminar presentation is a major part of the curriculum in most courses, and students are expected to present an effective presentation. For the purpose of awarding grades. Students receive guidance for presenting seminars. These Seminars are graded on their worth.
Evaluation through Inter-Personal, Soft Skills and Communication Skills	Students are actively involved in organization of seminars, conferences, workshops, classroom activities and evaluated on interpersonal Interactions and good behavior in order to identify academic capabilities. Students and research scholars from college are selected for leading, discipline controlling and monitoring for various purposes like social gatherings and research related activities based on their interpersonal relation skills management.

Institutional Policy for Learning Level of Assessment

- Every year teachers of all the departments compile the record of the marks of students at the entry-level.
- The students are sorted into the groups of high percentage, medium percentage, and low percentage. This is a baseline with the help of count marks of core subjects.
- With the help of Class Tests in the first-semester assessment of the baseline is defined.
- The subject teachers form the groups of slow learners and advanced learners and the information of the same is useful to handle the groups.
- The remedial classes are planned by the departments for all the slow learners. Sometimes, One- to-one guidance is provided to the students.
- Every Teacher engages lectures for problem-solving for slow learners.
- Internal Unit Tests are helpful to assess the improvement of the slow learner students.
- The slow learners give a positive response which is signified through their satisfactory results in the Internal Unit Test at the end of every semester.
- For the advanced learners, projects, assignments like power-point presentations, paper presentations, etc. are assigned.
- Advanced learners and slow learners are assigned to organize various National Seminars, Guest lectures, and State Level Debate Competitions, etc. for their soft skills development.
- Students have mixed formal peer groups of advanced and slow learners to solve their problems related to study and teachers also support such groups and provide guidance when it is needed.
- Advanced learners are motivated to appear for competitive examinations.
- The college has been organizing SET/NET/GATE classes. The efforts done by Career Guidance and Placement Cell with the coordination of Remedial

- Coaching Committee are reflected in the bright results of college and the number of successful students in SET/NET/GATE examinations. Reading room facility available for preparation of the examination.
- Advanced learners as well as slow learners are also motivated by providing them the information of the career options that promote the students to excel in their performance.
- The advanced learners are guided to appear for various entrance examinations for scholarships and fellowships.

Policy for Effective Leadership and Decentralization of Administration

The effective leadership is reflected through the decentralization management policy and strategies. The institute has well defined and participative management policy for decentralization. The Nanded Education Society governing council appoints the Principal for smooth and efficient college administration. The Governing council of N.E.S. also appoints Vice-Principal to decentralize the administration. To facilitate the administration and for smooth functioning of the academic activities intuition has formed different committees under the guidance of Principal and IQAC Coordinator. Principal of the college looks after the financial matters, institutional policies and strategies as well as development and research in various departments. He also deals with all the stakeholders with various issues. Principal briefs the policies of the institute in the staff meeting and also guides students in the orientation programme at the beginning of the academic year.

- 1. Faculty Level Management:** All the faculty members of the college are given responsibilities of different committees. The faculties are actively involved in academic, curricular and extra-curricular activities in the college which results in transparency and enrichment. Principal and IQAC Coordinator constitute the various committees through which all faculty gets the representation. Along with teaching, research faculties perform the role of Convener of the committee. The conveners of the representative committees conduct the meeting and perform various academic activities according to guidelines provided by the Principal.
- 2. Students Level Management:** The convener of the committee selects the students on committee according to his ability and for smooth functioning of work assigned to the committee. They actively involved in cultural, literary, student welfare, campus cleanliness, science association, anti-raging, organization of lecture series, national festivals, etc. Students also participate in debate competition, science fest, Avishkar, paper presentation, conference, seminars workshops of other colleges. The secretary of students' council put up the different problem of the students before Principal and solve with amicable solution. College helps NCC, NSS students to arrange camp and social work.
- 3. Non-teaching Staff Level Management:** The College also helps the non-teaching staff by organizing the hands on training. The institute helps to non-teaching to improve their skills to perform better and promote

participative management. The representative of non-teaching staff is on CDC and IQAC for effective participative management. The suggestions are considered in the policy making of the institute.

They constitute rules and regulations for admission, discipline in the campus, grievances of stakeholders, supportive services, examinations, finance and administration.
