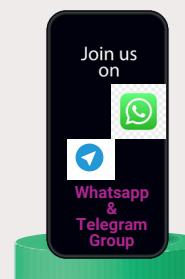

Nanded is the ancient historic city prevailing in the Marathwada region of Maharashtra. Historical evidence states that the Nanda Dynasty ruled the city for many generations during the 4th centuries and 5th centuries. This city was also a part of King Asoka’s Mauryan Empire. The mention about Nanded and its practice of irrigation are found in Lilacharitra, which is a treaty written by Mhaimbhatta over 700 years ago. Nanded: Sachkhand Gurudwara : Hazur Sahib One of the five Takhts of Sikhism, this sacred gurudwara is an important pilgrimage site. It marks the place where Guru Gobind Singh, the 10th Sikh Guru, spent his final days.

Kaleshwar Temple : Kaleshwar Temple is situated on the banks of river Godavari at Vishnupuri in Nanded and is a famous lord Shiva temple in Nanded taluka, Maharashtra. This temple is renowned for its location and the natural environment surrounding it from all sides. The temple is situated in on the banks of the River Godavari which flowed along the side of Nanded for nearly 800 years in the 13th century.

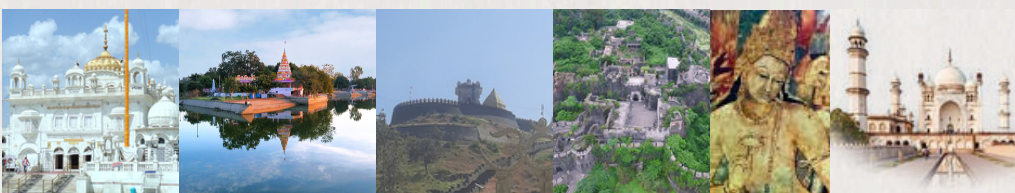
Vaidyanath Temple, Parali : 120 km away from the Nanded. Parli Vajinath Jyotirlinga, one of the twelve sacred Jyotirlingas in Hinduism, holds a significant place in the religious and cultural landscape of India. This ancient temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva, and it is believed to be associated with many legends and myths.

Renuka Devi Temple Mahur: Mahur is the abode of the goddess Renuka, mother of Parshuram, an incarnation of Lord Vishnu. The place is in Kinwat about 130 km away from Nanded. It is believed that the temple has been constructed by a Yadava king of Devgiri about eight or nine hundred years ago. The temple of Renukadevi is located on a hill top. There are carved caves in the hills around Mahur.

Kandhar Fort: Spread across 24 acres and situated seemingly in the middle of nowhere is the Kandhar fort, once the seat of the powerful Rashtrakuta dynasty that ruled over the Deccan between the 6th and 10th centuries CE. In a good condition and boasting some beautiful architectural features, the fort is on the banks of the Manyad river around 55 km from Nanded in Maharashtra.

Ajanta and Ellora Caves (Nearly 350 Km): A UNESCO World Heritage Site, these ancient rock-cut caves are world-famous for their exquisite sculptures, paintings, and carvings.

Bibi Ka Maqbara: Often referred to as the "Taj of the Deccan," this mausoleum was built in memory of Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb’s wife.
