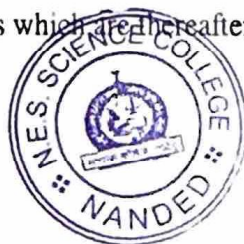
Constraints/Limitations:

- Due to huge response of the students it was difficult to manage the event even then the exhibition was made successful.
- The guides guiding the students for presentations in exhibition are limited in number.

Evidence of Success

- The evidence of success is that 463 students are benefitted by the talks of the eminent faculty and the event.
- Students present research ideas which are thereafter developed for entrepreneurship and startups.

Problems encountered are-





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Teachers today have to play the role of an educator, motivator and entertainer combined, rather than just a tutor. Most of the faculty members are a part of multiple departments/committees and it becomes challenging for them to work with optimum efficiency in every department/committee. Problems were overcome by carefully planning the activities.

Resources required-

- The required resources were faculty, judges, guides, trained trainers and faculty to handle the responsibilities assigned.
- Equipment's, audio-visual aids, electricity backup and generator facility, display boards, electrification.
- Financial resources to update the knowledge, technology and infrastructure time to time.

4. Title of the Practice: Best from Waste

Objectives of the Practice:

- To look into new approaches producing attractive items out of waste material that benefit society and are environmental friendly.
- To encourage students to use recycled materials
- To produce bio-fertilizer and vermi-compost made from garbage and plant waste.
- To produce and sell vermi-compost.
- To create awareness among farmers of the impact of chemical fertilizers on soil fertility and use of vermi-compost.

The Context:

- The "Eco-friendly Committee" is established by the institute to ensure eco-balance and

environmental preservation. The "Best from Waste" state-level competition, which is

organised by the eco-friendly committee each year, promotes environmental awareness among college students.





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A variety of events, including workshops, campus cleanliness initiatives, environmental awareness campaigns, tree plantation, poster presentations for environmental awareness.

Students from various universities took part in the "Best from Waste" competition and created a variety of models and posters using various forms of waste.

Students create manure and vermin-compost using garbage and tree leaves from our college's 45-acre campus.

Compost from vermin is a valuable source of humus and nutrients. All crop leftovers and organic waste are efficiently converted by it.

The Practice

A. We started composting vermin using the pit and bed approach. Composting is done in 5.5x26.5x3-foot cemented pits with a 2.5x3.5-foot outlet. The pits are constructed in the cool, damp, and shaded area. Green mesh covers the object. Cow dung and chopped dried leafy material were combined in a 1:3 ratio and maintained for 15 to 20 days. A layer of 15 to 20 cm chopped dried leaves were kept as bedding material at the bottom of the bed. Each bed was contained 1.5 to 2 sq.ft. of raw material. The numbers of beds were increased as per raw material availability. The earthworms were released on the upper layer of the bed. The water was sprinkled immediately after release of worms. The beds were turned once after thirty days for maintaining aeration and proper decomposition. The compost gets ready in 45 to 50 days. Harvesting was done when raw material was completely decomposed and it appeared black and granular. The watering was stopped and composts get ready. The compost was kept over a heap of partial decomposed cow dung for migration of earthworm to cow dung from compost.

B. After two days compost was separated and sieved and packed in small labeled bags which are used for home gardening and college gardens. A lush green garden,





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medicinal plant garden, green house, fruit plants are maintained with the use of Vermin-compost produced in the campus.

Evidence of success:

• **Students prepare different ornamental articles from waste materials.**

Students participated in the workshop conducted have been prepared some creative and beautiful models from e-waste, plastic waste and plant waste.

Students get benefited from the Vermin-compost practice implemented in the campus. They share their knowledge with farmers and other stake holders.

They even apply in their own farms.

Problems encountered-

Earthworms do not survive at high temperature is the problem encountered for vermi-composting. The protection of vermi-compost unit from other animals is also difficult task.

There were problems of Ants, Snakes, termites, centipedes, rats, pigs and birds.

Preventive measures were taken to protect the pits and earthworm by regular monitoring, fencing and application of anti-termites along the boundary of pits and applying 4 neem based insecticides before filling the heap.

Resources required-

The resources required for vermin-composting are

- Pit
- Plant waste particularly leaves
- soil
- cow dung
- water
- jaggery
- inoculum-earthworms
- Sieve
- Collection pots





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- Packing bags
- Sealing machine
- Finance
- Human resource
