- · Others (rubber, wood, ceramic etc.).







About the Workshop

E-waste or Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) is any electrical or electronic equipment which has been discarded. This entails working and broken things that are dumped into the landfill or offered to a reseller of charity such as Goodwill. Sometimes, it will be thrown away if the merchandise goes unsold in the market. E-waste is especially harmful because of poisonous chemicals that, when buried, spontaneously leach from the metals within.

There are also dangerous metallic chemicals in electrical devices, such as zinc, cadmium and beryllium, and brominated flame retardants The amount of iron, copper, aluminum, gold, and other metals in e-waste is about 60 percent, while plastics account for about 30 percent and just about 2.70 percent of dangerous contaminants. (10) Of



many poisonous heavy metals, lead is the most widely used for various uses in electrical products, resulting in a number of health risks due to environmental pollution. Lea Children are more vulnerable to lead poisoning because they ingest more lead from their surroundings and their nervous system and blood are affected, more so than adults. E-waste disposal practices have been shown to have led to increased levels of blood lead in
