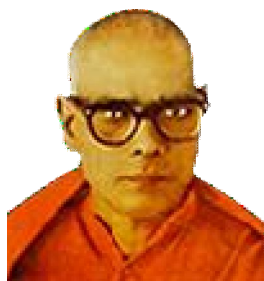

1. CODE OF CONDUCT AND ETHICS FOR STUDENTS:

All Students are requested to observe following Code of conduct and ethics:

DISCIPLINE

- Every student must carry I-card with him / her regularly and Uniform is compulsory.
- The student must observe and strictly follow the disciplinary rules and regulations set down by the college from time to time.
- Any act of indiscipline or misconduct by any student will attract punishment as per the rules.
- The student should follow the academic calendar as per the instructions of Head of the Department.
- Damage to college property due to negligence/lack of care/malicious action would attract punishment and compensation for loss caused.
- Students shall only use the waste bins for disposing waste materials in classrooms, hostels and offices to make the college campus free from plastic and other litter.
- Students have to park their vehicles in parking zone only.
- Students may not invite any person(s) to the institution to address or participate in any type of event without the prior permission of the appropriate college authorities.
- Disciplinary action will be initiated against students indulging in eve-teasing, molestation, ragging, harassment, bullying and any other untoward incidents.
- Unauthorized entry of outsiders into the campus as well as hostels is strictly prohibited. Without specific permission of the authorities, students shall not bring outsiders to the campus schools, hostels or other facilities.
- Any case of criminal activity or violation of law and order in the Campus will attract strict action and if need be, reported to the police.
- Mobile phones are not allowed on campus.
- Students should have at least 75% attendance in the Lectures of every subject.
- Students should use social media with responsibility.
- Students should follow all examination rules.
- Hostelites should follow all the rules of the hostel.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEACHING STAFF:

The college follows code of conduct of the affiliated university.
